On the reverse side of this form include a sketch of the sign, indicating the size, text of the sign, style of letters, color, etc. The applicant is responsible for submitting details of all existing signs at the proposed location.

- (b) The area of a sign composed of characters or words attached directly to a building or wall surface shall be the smallest rectangle which encloses the group.
- (c) Freestanding and facial signs in the O-P/R District shall be subject to approval of a certificate of appropriateness from the Scenic and Historic Preservation Commission prior to submission of a sign permit application.

- (a) Double-faced signs shall be considered two separate signs at the same location for the purpose of assessing permit fees.
- (b) Fees for each sign shall be doubled for sign permits issued after installation of such sign.

<sup>\*</sup>In order to erect a sign larger than is permitted, one must first apply to the Zoning Board of Appeals for an Area Variance.
