

Utica Green Waste Collection Is As Easy as 1 – 2 – 3

1. Place Grass and Leaves in Containers

All green waste must be placed in metal or plastic bins. **Do not use garbage bags, boxes or recycling containers.** You may have a **maximum of 5 containers** total. Place the green waste containers at the curb on the same night you set out your garbage and recycling. **Containers may not exceed 50 lbs.**

2. Bundle Brush, Branches & Shrubs

All brush, branches, shrubbery and twigs must be tied or bundled together. **Branches may not be longer than 4 feet.** Place these bundles at the curb for collection alongside your garbage and recycling. **Bundles may not exceed 50 lbs.**

3. Compost

Utica residents may deliver their green waste directly to the Oneida-Herkimer Solid Waste Authority's (OHSWA) Convenience Station at 80 Leland Avenue. Green waste is accepted Monday through Friday from 8:30am to 3:00pm and Saturdays from 7:00am to 2:00pm at **no charge**. Proof of residency is required and contractors are not eligible for this program. If you have large quantities of green waste (i.e. trees) call the OHSWA at 731-0238 for a removal quote.

Keep Green Waste Green!

Don't mix your green waste with paper products, plastics or metals.

Other Materials:

Utica residents may also set out a **maximum of 1 container** of dirt, bricks, rocks or concrete. Do not mix these materials with other green waste. **The container may not exceed 50 lbs.** If you have a larger quantity of dirt, bricks, rocks or concrete you may deliver these materials to OHSWA's Convenience Station at 80 Leland Avenue at **no charge** or call them at 731-0238 for a removal quote.
