LABORER – DPW

Salary: \$18.34 per hour

Classification: Non-Competitive, Teamsters position
Candidates must be legal residents of the City of Utica and maintain residency throughout employment.

Distinguishing Features of the Class:

This position is responsible for the routine manual work requiring physical endurance and a willingness to perform menial tasks. Work is performed in accordance with policies and objectives outlined by the department head. Work is performed under constant supervision. Does related work as required.

Typical Work Activities:

Assists in patching and grading streets;
Installs trees, shrubs, and retaining walls;
Loads and unloads trucks;
Cleans and maintains streets, park areas, culverts, basins, playgrounds, and restroom facilities;
Clears clogged sewers;
Removes snow from streets, sidewalks, parks and recreational areas;
Assists in the repair of sewers and catch basins;
Digs and refills trenches for water pipe lines;
Assists in repairing sweepers and making brooms;
Puts up and takes down swings, other recreational equipment, Christmas lights, and snow fencing;
Cuts grass, trims shrubs, rakes leaves, spades flower beds, and assists in ground maintenance activities;
Conditions ice skating rinks, tennis courts, baseball diamonds, swimming pools, cross country tracks, recreation trails; and
Oils and cinders streets;
Directs trucks on dump grounds;
Oversees and participates in ash dumping, dump cleaning and leveling;
Washes, greases, lubricates, checks, and vacuums automotive equipment in and out of garage;
Picks up city wide trash cans;
Performs general building and grounds cleaning tasks.

Required Knowledge Skills and Abilities:

Willingness to perform routine manual work; ability to lift heavy weights; willingness to work under all weather conditions; knowledge of the policies and procedures of the department; ability to follow oral and written directions; ability to get along well with others; tact and courtesy; and dependability. Physical condition commensurate with the demands of this position.
